### What is this product?

This product is an investment fund.

#### Objectives

**Investment objective** The objective of this Sub-Fund is to provide highly competitive gross rates of return which exceed the return of the ICE BofA US 3-Month Treasury Bill Index (G0O1 Index).

Investment policies For this purpose, the Sub-Fund may invest, inter alia, in negotiable debt securities and other short and medium term instruments, fixed and floating rate bonds and money market products, including convertible bonds, as well as equities on an ancillary basis. A minimum of 70% of the net assets of the Sub-Fund will be invested in the signatures of investment grade issuers (as defined by Moody's, Standard & Poor's, Fitch or Bloomberg using the DRSK function) as well as in liquidity and similar instruments. The Sub-Fund may invest in UCITS compatible with the investment objective of the Sub-Fund, up to a maximum of 50% of its net assets. At least 95% of the net assets of the Sub-Fund will be invested in financial instruments with a residual maturity of up to three (3) years (including cash on current account representing up to 10% of the Sub-Fund's assets). The maximum average weighted residual term to maturity of the Sub-Fund will be eighteen (18) months. The Sub-Fund may hold, on an ancillary basis, up to 20% of its net assets in cash (i.e. bank deposits on call, such as cash held in current accounts at a bank which is accessible at any time) for liquidity purposes or in case of adverse market conditions. This limit may only be exceeded temporarily for a period of time strictly necessary when, due to exceptionally adverse market conditions, circumstances so require and such excess is justified in the interests of the shareholders, for example in very serious circumstances such as the September 11 attacks or the collapse of Lehman Brothers in 2008. If the Investment Manager considers it to be in the best interests of the shareholders, the Sub-Fund may also hold, on a temporary basis and for defensive purposes, up to 100% of its net assets in cash.

The Sub-Fund will not invest in CoCos or distressed securities. The Sub-Fund will neither invest in asset backed securities (ABS) nor in mortgage backed securities (MBS) as well.

The Sub-Fund is actively managed. The Investment Manager has complete freedom in choosing which assets to buy, hold and sell in the Sub-Fund, subject to the investment restrictions and guidelines set out in this Prospectus. Therefore, the composition of the portfolio holdings is not constrained by the composition of the index and the deviation of portfolio holdings from the index may be significant.

The sub-fund is not a Money Market Fund.

**Derivative Policy** For investment and/or hedging purposes, the Sub-Fund may also use financial derivative instruments whose underlyings are securities belonging to the categories defined above or notional amounts related to these same categories of securities. The Sub-Fund will not enter into swap transactions. The Sub-Fund will also neither make use of securities financing transactions in form of securities lending nor of total return swaps.


